

Hardware Component Instructions

The main hardware components of the SIP-T22P IP phone are the LCD screen and the keypad.



Hardware component instructions of the SIP-T22P IP phone are:

	Item	Description
1)	LCD Screen	Shows information about calls, messages, soft keys,
		time, date and other relevant data:
		Call information — caller ID, call duration
		• Icons (for example, DND)
		Missed call text or second incoming caller information
		Prompt text (for example, "Saving files! Please wait")
		Time and date
2	Power Indicator LED	Indicates phone power status.
3	Line Keys	Use these keys to activate up to three accounts.
4	MESSAGE Key	Indicates and accesses voice messages.
(5)	HEADSET Key	Toggles and indicates the headset mode.
6	FORWARD Key	Forwards a call to another number.
7	Redial Key	Redials a previously dialed number.
8	Speakerphone Key	Toggles the hands-free speakerphone mode.
9	Volume Key	Adjusts the volume of the handset, headset, speaker, and ringer.
10	Keypad	Provides the digits, letters, and special characters in context-sensitive applications.
	$\bigcirc \bigcirc \bigcirc \bigcirc \bigcirc$	Scroll through the displayed information.
11)	ОК	Confirms actions or answers an incoming call.
	×	Cancels actions or rejects an incoming call.
(12)	Soft Keys	Labels automatically to identity their context-sensitive
		features.
